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Kansas City on October 10 this year, a famous theologian speaking. Had I said what he said, the ministers and priests would

me "atheist" and everything else so good. As a matter of fact, I have been saying for twelve years what this noted "divine" said; but if you say it, why, the Methodist church takes its neck to get my Assistant Attorney General Tenney out of here, because the doctrines we teach are not those of the Methodist church. Thank God we are not. We are doing things for mankind. We are doing what the Methodist or any other church has never yet been able to do. We are bringing man and God together, here and now, not in some future time far away above the sky, but right here on earth when and where we can actually enjoy the benefits which a life lived with God brings with it. These are days in which the honest men in the church are looking the lies right squarely in the face. They are looking back over their accomplishments and lack of accomplishments. They see world conditions as they are today, and these good honest men are not satisfied. They smell a rat. They sense that their conception of God will never save this world; for in spite of it, they see horror and bloodshed on every hand. They see the rise of dictators. They see misery on every hand. They see the future of our own beloved land threatened, and a sense of the danger creeps in on them.

When they turn their eyes to their own religion, and they ask themselves why it is that all they have to offer is "beyond the tomb." They analyze their theology, and they, in disgust, decide that they have nothing whatsoever which can stand against the perils of today. "Beyond the sky" may be right, but the chances are there are perils "up yonder." In any event, these good honest churchmen know well, or at least they suspect, that their conception of God is utterly use-

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less when it comes to doing anything to halt the spread of despotism on this earth. All the praying of all the church members in the world can't stop Hitler, and this is what my good honest church friends are finding out. In other words, in very high places, honest men are distraught with their own theologies. They know that they have nothing which can stem the increasing tide of atheism, horror, and misery which sweeps Europe and Asia, and which shortly will sweep the entire world. They know that.

I say to these good brethren that if they have nothing in their theologies which can step into this world's troubled picture and bring God to it, whatever theology they have cannot be of God. They may think it is. They may say it is, and they may teach that it is; but if those theologies cannot actually throw their power against such idiots as Hitler and others, those theologies are not of God. They cannot be, for God is Right, among other things; and whenever you see *wrong* prevailing against the *Right*, you may make up your mind that God is not in evidence. There may be one hundred million church members on their knees, but if they are unable to stop the brutality which is harrowing and harrassing this world today, what they have and what they teach cannot be of God.

I have been saying this for twelve years, and it's cost me plenty to say it. It's cost my family much misery and grief, and it has cost me tens of thousands of dollars protecting myself against those religious fanatics who, because I said their story is not true, tried to play politics in high places to either put me in the federal penitentiary or ship me out of the country. Yes, I've suffered in this fight for God. Don't ever think I haven't. I am prepared to suffer more. In fact, I

am prepared to die an ignominious death in the cause of the truths of God, any time it may be necessary; for I would rather die for a cause

which must ultimately triumph, than I would live for a cause which cannot permanently endure, and the present church theologies cannot permanently endure.

Now, let us see what this noted "divine" had to say. Don't ever think anyone will persecute him for saying it. As a matter of fact, I am receiving letters from "higher-ups" in the churches, and, believe it or not, they agree with me. They are finally coming to the conclusion that "that man Robinson in Moscow" has a divinely inspired vision, coupled with the Spiritual Power to put that divine vision across to the multitudes. They are finally coming to see that my vision, in fact, my whole Movement, really is the Movement through which the Spirit of God is manifesting Its truths to humanity. Not all churches have come around yet. Not all church members think I'm O. K. They still malign and blaspheme me and my work; but many of the leaders are seeing the Light which is God, and that makes me supremely happy, I assure you.

There never has been anything of merit to me. There never will be. I am probably the weakest piece of human machinery God ever let live; but —*God has chosen the thing which is not, to bring to naught the things which are.* When the Spirit of God decided the time was ripe to begin to move in the hearts of men, He did not go to some pastor, priest, or famous theologian. No, He came to Moscow, Idaho; and there He found a man who was willing to believe in the actual presence and Power of God, even though by so believing it might cost him his liberty, his honor, and his reputation. That's the sort of man through whom God chose to reveal Himself. As usual when God moves, His movements upset all human cal-

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Truly It Is Amazing

There lies before me a letter from a well-known physician, a personal friend of the family and one who was on my case recently during the severe heart attack I suffered. And then, as the years go by, and as the Movement comes more and more into the public eye, they change their opinions. Perhaps a copy of this magazine gets into their hands. Perhaps they know of someone who has been healed or who has had some other glorious experience as a result of the Power of God in their lives. Who knows in what manner it happens. But it does happen. Once in a while we find a newspaper or magazine which shies off at our advertising, but

very seldom. Just as soon as that one really begins to investigate, their columns are wide open to us, for they cannot investigate without finding out that God is the impelling force behind us. If that were not so, I should not be here at the head of this Movement, I assure you. What God can do truly is amazing.

The Power of the Spirit of God is not confined to physical healing, for I look upon that as a very minor thing. The physical body is but the house in which the Spirit of Life dwells for a time. As such, it should be carefully looked after. But is not the indwelling Power of Life, or God, of infinitely more importance than the receptacle in which that life lives? I think it is—I am sure it is. The future of the human race, and the bringing of peace to this earth depend entirely upon the recognition and understanding of this invisible Power of God, the Creator of us all. All too little attention has been paid to this spiritual side of us, although in that spiritual side lies the answer to all of life's problems, as well as the future of the human race.

Misguided religionists have made a terrible mess of teaching the truths of God. They have not known those truths, so never could successfully teach them. Instead of reasoning things out for themselves, they have listened to what someone back in the dark ages taught, and we are asked to believe that God Almighty, the Great Spirit of all life, was killed on a cross some 2,000 years ago. Let me say that as long as that theology is taught, this world cannot know God, because the Infinite Spirit of God is not to be found in such a philosophy, if it can be called that.

This is what the world has to learn. When it learns this, you will see no such horrible madness as is sweeping the universe today. It is not permanent, but it is horrible while it lasts. The bad thing about it is that the only Power which can stop it is not recognized by anyone or any system of religion in existence. They all stick by the dark age teachings of God

making a mistake when He created man, requiring the death of God on a cross to atone for the "sins" of man God created without even asking man whether he wanted to be created or not. That is the pity of the world today. Under such teachings, of course, God cannot manifest on earth. I make bold enough to say unless this Movement of mine steps quickly into the front of the religious picture, these war-mad, insatiable dictators will get away with their brutal murderings for a much longer period than would otherwise be necessary.

This true picture of God, as we are bringing that picture to the world, must inevitably be known to all, very soon at that. If it should be that this picture is not brought to the world, then our beloved peaceful civilization as we know it here in America will fall. However, we stand at a crisis in human affairs. God is necessary to the future peace and happiness of the human race, and in this dark hour you may depend upon God. God has chosen His man and His Movement through which the inspired truths of Time and Eternity will be manifested to all men. The dictators then will have to see the Light, or they will not, those of us who know the Power of the Spirit of God will then be forced to throw that Spirit of Power against them in such a degree that they will come to their end. That will be done. These truths of God are so sublimely simple though they are, that they are the only truths on this earth to which can stop this mad rush of men.

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Questions and Answers

Q: Is it your idea of God that we must always look upon him as a Spirit with no physical manifestation in the flesh at all?

A: Certainly—so far as a human manifestation of God goes. The theory that "God was manifested in the flesh" of one man is grossly incorrect. Yet all around us, on every hand, we see physical manifestations of God. The final and absolute end of man will come in that day in which man recognizes the fullness of the invisible Spirit of God in him. There could be nothing better than that. No one at any time has ever seen God—yet we see God in everything He created. What I am trying to say is that when man attains his fullness, he will know to the very full what it means to have the Invisible Spirit which is God dwelling in him to the very fullest extent. Then, through the indwelling Power of the Spirit of God, man can live forever in perfect peace with other men and nations can lay down their arms, because the staggering immensity of the fact that God does live in man can then fade into the shadows everything else. Man has not yet progressed to the place at which he will recognize God in him. He wants a god in the sky—he wants a god anywhere, just so long as God is removed from the human race. That is what religion, as we know it, has taught. It is a false teaching. It is a pagan teaching and it came entirely from older and pagan systems of religion. Our new conception of God will be grasped some day soon, and when it is, what a change there will be. Man and God living in perfect consciousness of each other. Could you ask for more than that?

Q: I am about to commit suicide. I am despondent and see no hope for the future. I don't see what use there is to life. I don't understand it. I didn't ask to be put here, and I don't want to stay here—it's all a mess and I'm going to get out of it, but will wait till I hear from you. Maybe you have something to suggest. Have you?

A: No. I have nothing to suggest. You are a very small speck in the eternal scheme of things, and you won't be missed at all. The world will go round just the same without you. Of course you did not ask to be put here. Neither did I. Neither did anyone else. The difference between you and the rest of us is that you are afraid of life. You see little use in it. I'm not so sure but what your decision is a good one. When a man gets as low down the moral scale as you are, perhaps what you suggest is the best thing—who knows. I imagine you are fishing for sympathy my friend, but I'm sorry I can give you none. You can be sure of one thing—this world does not want cowards. It wants men who will tackle the problems of life, knowing that God and justice shall prevail, and it's quite evident you are not that sort of a person. I'm

guessing that you haven't got the nerve to get rid of yourself. Every so often I receive a letter like yours, and my reply usually makes the writer so mad that he or she forgets about suicide. I hope this is so in your case, and I'm betting it is. Suppose you study my Lessons and get the real truths of life and God. You can be a real man yet, if you will.

Q: How do you think a religion without sentiment, like yours, can save this world?

A: I don't see what "sentiment" has to do with religion. But just in case you think there is no sentiment in our religion may I say to you that communion with God is about the most beautiful thing I know. Don't let anyone tell you that there is no sweetness in the presence of God. There's lots of it. Sentiment, alone, has no direct bearing upon the truths of God. True religion seeks to reveal God to man, and that revelation is made without sentiment. But after God has been revealed to anyone, if sentiment is what such a one is looking for, it surely can be found in true religion. One usually finds though that his complete time is taken up telling others about the Spirit of God, and there's little time for religious fervor. Life with God is too deep for shallow emotion. God brings peace to men. And peace is far more to be cherished than even joy. Some day, when this world has been redeemed, there will be lots of time for sentiment and emotion, but just now my time is too taken up throwing the Spirit of God against Hitler and old Musso to even think about emotion.

Q: What will happen to "PSYCHIANA" when you die?

A: The work of God is never dependent upon any one man. When I go you will find that "PSYCHIANA" will continue to do its work as now. It may do it better without me than with me—I don't know.

Q: I am pastor of the _____ Four Square Church at _____ and I challenge you to a debate in our city, the subject to be "WAS JESUS GOD?" I will take the affirmative side and you are to take the negative side. If you do not accept this challenge I shall take it that you have no scriptural grounds for your stand. May I hear from you accepting this challenge?

A: That would be O.K. but such a debate would get just exactly nowhere. You are unknown in the religious world, and I absolutely have neither the time nor the inclination to debate religious issues with you. My work is to bring to men and women the superlative truths of the existence of God in the lives of all men and women. You say if I refuse you will take it to mean that I have no scriptural grounds for my stand. Certainly not, as I do not accept your scriptures. Incidentally, I was in Venice when thousands of Aimee's poor dupes were watching for her to come up out of the sea. I also was in Carmel later, and spoke to the lady who owned the house where she is supposed to have stayed. You can't tell the people of Carmel that Aimee disappeared in the Arizona desert, or was kidnaped, for they know better. I suggest you

find the truths of God before you try to lead others into those truths. You certainly do not know them now or you would not be preaching the Four Square teaching.

culations. "Why, that man is an atheist—he denies that Jesus was killed on a cross—he denies that Jesus was God—he says God lives here and now in the lives of human beings—why, they ought to put him in the penitentiary—he's destroying our religion." That is what they say. It is a fact that I am destroying their religion; but I am also replacing their religion with God's religion, and that's far better, I think.

Man's religion will never save anyone or anything. God's religion can save the whole world, and the time is getting close when that will happen. Just a few more years to roll by. Just a little bit more misery to be suffered throughout the world. Then, in that shining day which I see so clearly, God's religion will speak. It is speaking now through this Movement. When we are able to step boldly into the world picture in a big way, God's religion will speak more and more; and humanity, catching the true conception of God, will, at last—at long

last—begin to believe God. In that believing the world will find rest. May the day be hastened. May I be given strength and finances sufficient for this Great Day of God.

The man I am talking about in Kansas City was Dr. William A. Eddy, president of Hobart and William Smith colleges. He was addressing an Episcopal convention. I quote his words verbatim. Listen; then recall the letter I received from a very prominent Episcopalian a few days ago. Add them up, for they do add up. Here is the statement of Dr. Eddy, delivered before that Episcopal convention. I quote:

"Christians are scattered. We are lost and despised. We live in a world that is given over entirely to power, and we must prove that we stand for strength and not for weakness. Being a Christian today calls for martyrdom in a day when naturalism and nationalism are the exclusive religions of the brutalitarians who have all but conquered the modern world."

I could not have put that much plainer myself, I don't think. It's interesting to hear such statements made; but I want to look into that statement for just a few moments. Perhaps we can set Dr. Eddy on the right track. We have set more than one "divine" on the right track, and we have set hundreds of thousands of those of us who are not "divine"—just common people—on the right track. So let us see if we can't find out just why Christians are in such a kettle of fish.

In the first place, Dr. Eddy states that Christians are scattered, lost, and despised. If they are, it is their own fault. You see, no one asked the Christian church to step into the world picture with its philosophy of religion. It came of its own free will. It says to you, and to me: "Here we are; we have a theory of God, and if you don't believe what we tell you, you are to be eternally damned after you die." That, in effect, is what the Christian religion tells the world. It tells us that "there is none other name given under heaven whereby man may be saved," than the name of their own peculiar god. It tells the world that 2,000 years ago, God

Almighty came down from heaven to be killed on a cross, and it tells us further that the name of Jesus is the only way to eternal life. It does not tell us what is going to happen to the millions who lived on this earth thousands of years before the "god" of the Christians was ever heard of. Does it tell us how it happens that, before the supposed time of Christ, the world had known about 35 or 40 "gods," all of whom came down from heaven to "save the world."

The Christian church does not tell us that its every fundamental, all of them, are to be found in the religions which are today called "heathen." As a matter of fact, the whole Christian story, as you well know, is known in detail to more millions of Hindoos than ever followed the Christian religion; yet these "heathens" knew the story of a crucified god 1,400 years before the Christian religion was ever heard of. The Christian does not attempt to explain that. He doesn't even want to hear about that. I do. I want to hear about every "crucified god" this world has ever known. I want to compare them. I want to analyze every story of every religion—and it's a good thing I have such an inquiring mind; otherwise the story of the true Spirit of God might never have been brought to the world.

Dr. Eddy says Christians are "scattered and despised." They certainly are both; and the fact that they are "scattered" if they but knew it, is prima facie evidence that they know not!

whatsoever about God. Those who know God and those who follow God are never lost. Instead, the presence of the Spirit of God in them is a guiding beacon, which never allows those who know it to become lost. This statement of my friend, the "divine," condemns the whole Christian structure as being entirely outside the pale knowledge of the Spirit of God. To be lost is to be away from God. At least that's what the Christian church teaches. It tells me that I am lost outside of Jesus Christ. It tells you the same thing; yet one of its most prominent scholars tells the world that the Christian church itself is lost. I should like to help the Christian church find itself, but I can't get inside its doors.

It admits that its philosophy of God has led it astray: it admits that it is lost; and yet, when the one man who has the truths of God wants to help it, it refuses to be helped. It would rather hang onto its traditions—the same traditions which have led to the brink of ruin—than it would have its feet put upon the right track. I love the Christian church. I would give my life to help it find God; but I can't do that as long as it insists on following the path which not only has made the Christian church "despised and lost," but also has brought this world to the God-less condition it is now in. The churches of all denominations are directly responsible for world conditions today. I'll tell you why. They have come to this world and they have told it that they, and they alone, represent God. They have told us that they, and they alone, know the truths of God, and they have handed us a man-made anonymous bible and told us it was the "divinely inspired word of God, absolutely true from cover to cover." They have forgotten completely about the other bibles of older religions, which existed long before the Christian religion existed. They have asked this world to believe an utterly impossible and unbelievable story of God Almighty being crucified on a cross some 2,000 years ago. They have told us everything except how to know the Power of the Great Spirit, God, here and

now. They have told us what we shall get "after we die." They have told us all about "heaven" and the angels, and the "big book." They have told us all about the streets of gold and the gates of pearl. They have told us all about the tears being wiped away from all eyes—but it's all "after we die." There is nothing in the Christian or any other religion which can tell us something about how to know the Spirit of God here and now, to such a true degree that we can use that Power against such parasites as Hitler et al.

The Christian church knows nothing about that. Its promises are all "in the future," while the church reaps the material benefits down here. Millions in cash and property are in the treasury of all the churches; yet they tell us to wait till "beyond the tomb" for our reward. Dr. Eddy, I admit with you that the church is both "lost and despised," to use your own words; and I will tell you the reason for that. *You do not have the true picture of God. Your story of Jesus Christ on a cross, and being God Almighty, is not true. It is the Hindoo story told once more.* That's what's the matter with your churches, Dr. Eddy; and, Dr. Eddy, I should like to make a prediction: *until the Christian church throws away pagan superstitions and finds the true Spirit of God right here on this earth, it will become more lost and despised. You have a chance now, before it is too late, to turn to the true God as that Spirit is being manifested through this Movement. If you do that, you can still rise joyously triumphant; if you do not do that, you will pass into oblivion.*

The choice is yours, Dr. Eddy. I want to help you. I am here on this earth for the express purpose of revealing the truths of God to man. God, in His infinite wisdom, has seen fit to give the true vision to me. This true vision, Dr. Eddy, is not your story. Your story is not true. Won't you get rid of it in order that this world may be saved—truly saved? I trust that you will; but with your present heathen philosophy, you cannot. The Founder of this Movement will be very glad to meet the heads of the Episcopal church and set its feet on the right path. There is a wonder-

ful opportunity in these last days for the Christian church to rise to heights never before dreamed of—but it must forget the "dead, crucified god" theory. It must learn of the one here in Moscow who has been called of God to bring His truths to the world. Personally, this man in Moscow who is writing to you means just absolutely nothing; but he is the man chosen by God to bring deliverance to this war-torn world, and the Christian church, too. If the churches will let him, he can set their feet on the right road—the road that leads to God. The decision either for or against this lies with the Christian church.

Now, in conclusion, let my Students everywhere manifest so much of the Power of the Spirit of God that those around them shall know that they know God. Keep up the affirmations against Hitler. Already we see the handwriting on the wall. Stay close to the "great silent God." Recognize its presence and Power from first thing in the morning till last thing at night. Stand behind me with your financial support; and, together, at the proper time (now), we shall be able to bring to this suffering world, not the Christian theory of God, but the actual truths and Power of the Spirit of God. Will you do this? Thank you.

There is little mystery about this Movement, although you can hear it referred to as a "mysterious" Movement. It is probably the most discussed religious Movement in existence among other religions, yet none of them know what we are teaching. What I want to do is to let them all know what we are teaching, and I want to make such a spiritual drive against these world-dictators that their end shall be speedy and sure.

Hitler is done. Like Napoleon and Bismarck, he discovered that he could not invade Britain, and so he has turned his attention to the Balkans. Many may be alarmed as they see nation after nation falling. But that signifies nothing at all. There is no honor or credit due a strong nation which bluffs and frightens a smaller nation. Of course, Yugoslavia went over to the German camp—there was nothing else it could do. As far as Hitler is concerned, he is the biggest false alarm and phoney leader this world has ever known. He is a coward of the first water, and I want to say to every one of my Students this Sunday afternoon that he has no more chance of withstanding the Power of God which we of "Psychiana" are throwing against him than has the proverbial snowball. As soon as we began to throw the Power of the Spirit of God against the maniac, he began to slip. He has been slipping ever since.

Right is right, for God is God. And one man, and one organization which believes absolutely in either right or God, is bound to win. This is doubly so when one actually knows who and what the God he or she be-

lieves in is, and where such a God is. God is the Power behind all life and behind everything right. God, as life, actually lives in each one of us *as our very life itself*. Then do you not see how very easy it is to actually commune with God? All you have to do is to be alone, and there, recognizing the presence of God in you, hold your daily and hourly communion. Let me say to you that the invisible Realm of the Great Spirit—God, is infinitely more full of joy and everything good than you will ever realize. There has been a sort of a veil separating man from God, or that is, what we have been taught. But in these days of crisis, this veil is being penetrated, and believe me, I know what I am talking about when I say to you that eye hath not seen, nor hath ear heard, nor has it entered into the heart of man the glories which lie at our disposal in the Realm of the Spirit of God. Once more, believe me, I *know*.

The next few months and perhaps years will bring to this earth the greatest spiritual upheaval this world has ever known. It will be epochal. It will transcend mortal imagination. And yet, it is so close. The Spirit of God will deal with old Musso, Adolf, and Matsuoko, too, before too long, for time has reached the place where men and women actually are demanding to know God. When that happens, you may depend upon it they will know God. You good folks may think that I mention money too much. But I don't. If I do, you must excuse it. I only want to be in a financial position to open the eyes of the whole world to whom and what God is. Naturally, operating as we do by mail, this is expensive. Some day, this Movement will not need money. People will give me more than I can need. But until that day comes, I must depend upon the faithful ones, and those faithful ones will not disappoint me. The response so far has been good. More than \$2000 has been received. But our goal is \$100,000 and I shall not be satisfied until it is reached. Perhaps some of you are in touch with some wealthy man or woman who does not know of this Movement. I don't know. But I do know that any Movement grounded

in the Spirit of God as this Movement is, can never fail. I may have to wait a year, or even longer, before the sum of money needed is sent in. But then, that's all right. I know in Whom I believe, and am persuaded that the Power knows all about me. It knows all about you, too. And if you do your part, and I do mine, the day will surely come when we shall all together march onward to a wonderful victory for God and humanity.

I feel my frailty quite a bit these days. But I know that the strength of the Spirit of Infinite Life in me is the Pilot on board my ship. That being the fact, there is nothing left for me to do than to be instant, in season and out of season. If I am, I shall surely and you will see, the glory of the Spirit of God manifested in a way which you little dream of now. Many letters are coming in asking if the heart attack I suffered has hurt me permanently. I am happy to state that I am working again full blast, and shall do so until I drop, if needs be. I feel fine. While this attack was very serious, and while the average man would have died, I told you how the mastery was achieved. Well, I shall know the Spirit of the Eternal God in me, and that Spirit is so far above earthly things that the one who realizes that Supreme Presence is satisfied indeed.

No, the donations are not limited to \$100. More or less, as you feel you can give, will be very gratefully received, and the Infinite Spirit of God will lay His hand upon every one who helps this work. Soon, the shadows will permanently fall for perhaps 20 or 25 years more. But there is one thing I want to do, and that is to bring this conception of God to the whole world first, before those shadows fall. That done, I will not reckon what happens then. For the falling of the curtain on my little life will mean the raising of the curtain on His great Life, and, my life being hid in the Life of God, there shall be, with you, through all eternity. May the Spirit of the Infinite Creator of all Life be with each one of us forever. This I pray. It will be so.

"My Dear Dr. Robinson:

"So many wonderful things have come to me since my last note. I am now living in a beautiful home in California with my husband, from whom I had been separated for several years, and I must say we are happier now than ever before. Everything just seems to come to us now, that I have always wanted.

"What 'Psychiana' has done for me can never be told by mere words. When I first wrote you several years ago, things could never have looked blacker, but now I have, and get, all that my heart desires. I am enclosing

my husband's card. He is back in active duty in the navy."

You will agree that this lady knows whereof she speaks. The true satisfaction to me in this work is to see the God-Law actually work by being drawn upon in so many tens of thousands of lives. These good Students, once they have learned to draw upon the Power of God, never forget how to do this. They do it day and night, and as a result of this Indwelling Spirit, naturally, everything they need comes to them, be it material or spiritual things.

This beloved country of ours is going to be embroiled in this ghastly war. I can't see anything else. I believe it is too late for anyone to stop this very definite drift into this conflagration.
