

PALOUSE WELCOME VIEW TO TRAVELER

Dr. F. B. Robinson Finds Europe Armed Camp; Trip Ends Hurriedly

In 18,000 miles of travel he found nothing that compared to the Palouse district for prosperity and peace, Dr. Frank B. Robinson of Psychiana declared Monday upon his return from a seven-weeks tour of Europe and the Mediterranean. Dr. Robinson arrived in Spokane by plane from New York and in Moscow at 3 o'clock Monday morning.

Visiting relatives in England and Scotland for several days, he made a brief swing through Paris, Berlin, tarried for the Passion Play at Oberammergau, Bavaria, and went south to Genoa, Italy. From there he toured the Mediterranean, Palestine, and Egypt, returning to this country by way of London.

Armies in Control

"I am convinced there are only two really civilized nations on the face of the earth," he said Monday. They are Great Britain and the United States. The rest of the world is run over by military machines that have control of everything. The best thing this nation can do is to build thousands of airplanes, the biggest navy in the world, maintain a standing army of a million men, and then let the rest of them do as they please."

Dr. Robinson said he was in Berlin the night of Hitler's "purge" of the nazi party and on advice of the American consul left immediately. He saw a part of the heavy movement of troops around the German and Italian borders. He said in London he talked for half an hour with the Prince of Wales. His trip was cut short by the illness of his daughter, Florence, and upon receiving word that she was seriously ill engaged reservations on the Bremen from London, left that ship by plane catapulted from the vessel a thousand miles out of New York, and finished the trip to Spokane by air.
