BELIEVES IN TOLERANCE

To the Editor:

Persecution does not belong to the past altogether, even in this "the land of the free." Mistaken zeal, contemptible jealousy and downright meanness seem to have been the underlying motives, and are yet today, perhaps.

In the case of Dr. Frank B. Robinson, I don't believe it would take much detective work to discover the sources as well as the motives for what looks very much like persecution—of course looks are sometimes deceiving.

Dr. Robinson has shown himself to be a man of ability, of initiative, of pep and push. He has apparently succeeded financially. He has done quite a bit for Moscow. He deserves better than petty persecution. If there is a technical error as to his right to be here that should be possible of correction without much furor. If he is not a citizen, I think that no one will question his fitness for citizenship.

I wonder if this another tempest in a teapot?

I hold no brief for Dr. Robinson as a religious teacher or founder of religion—that is another matter. But my sense of fairness, of tolerism, and of neighborliness urges me to write this.

New Building Planned to House "Psychiana"

That "Psychiana" is to have a new home more than twice as large as its present building was revealed here today when it was disclosed that Dr. F. B. Robinson has entered into negotiations for the purchase of four lots which will give "Psychiana" a building having more than 10,000 square feet of floor space.

Dr. Robinson informed the Daily News-Review that he expected to close this deal shortly and that a new building would be erected on this property. He stated that the present building is far too small to accommodate the rapidly increasing growth of "Psychiana". Dr. Robinson disclosed further that for some time detailed and extensive plans have been under way for the opening of 1500 "Psychiana" churches in the United States and Canada. He said that if the present growth of "Psychiana" continues he would not be surprised to see a 20-story building here in Moscow inside of the next ten years. Dr. Robinson stated that the entire 1500 branches will probably be operating inside of the next two years and said that he would devote most of his time to this end of the movement.

Has Rapid Growth

"Psychiana" was formed here in Moscow about seven years ago and started in one small room. Inside of six months three additional rooms became necessary and inside of a year the premises now occupied by the Queen City Printing company were leased. "Psychiana" occupied this space less than a year and again larger quarters became necessary. Dr. Robinson

then bought the property on the corner of Third and Jackson and operated in a two-story building for about 18 months, building the present "Psychiana" building when more space was needed. The present building gives "Psychiana" about 3600 feet of floor space and is far too small for the volume of business being handled. Dr. Robinson told the News-Review today that never in the seven years of "Psychiana" existence has such a volume of business been transacted as is being transacted now.

"Psychiana" teaching in one year went into 67 different countries and now has hundreds of thousands of students and followers all over the world. It is generally recognized that this teaching has had a more rapid growth than any other religious teaching in history. Dr. Robinson plans to ordain 1500 ministers who will have charge of the 1500 churches he plans to open up. These ministers will all be chosen from his list of students.

Move News-Review

Dr. Robinson told a News-Review reporter today that at the expiration of the present lease on the News-Review building he plans to move it into the building now occupied by "Psychiana" as the growth of the News-Review has been almost as phenomenal as the growth of "Psychiana" and requires considerably more space than it now occupies.

When questioned by the News-Review regarding the deportation proceedings started against him, Dr. Robinson stated that he had no comment to make at this time.
