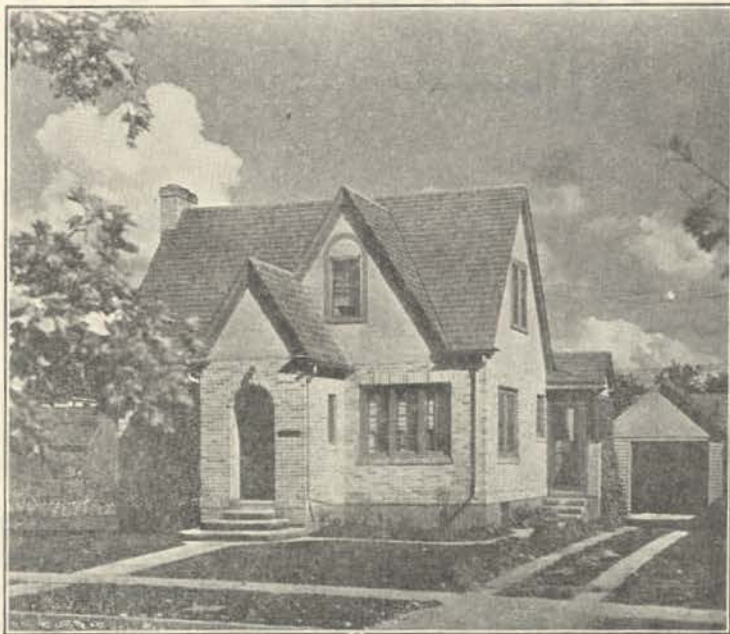
PRIVATE HOME HAS PIPE ORGAN

The only residential pipe organ in Idaho—probably the only one in the Inland Empire—has recently been built and installed by J. Riley Chase, organ engineer, Spokane, in the residence of Dr. Frank B. Robinson, Moscow, Idaho. Mr. Chase recently completed the complicated job, which required 10 days.

"This is a standard theater-type Geneva organ," said Mr. Chase. "It has five ranks—flute, tibia, vox humana, violin and celeste. It also has xylophone and orchestra bells and is fully unified. There are 365 pipes in all. It is entirely adequate for residential use.

"Dr. Robinson has completed a soundproof room in the basement, where the pipes have been installed. The tone is directed into the living room through a grill, not unlike a furnace register. It is nine inches wide and five feet long. The arrangement gives plenty of tone without a deafening effect.

"The organ is blown by a two horse-power rotary blower, which, with the tremolo and relay, is put in a separate soundproof room in the basement. It is so quiet that it is almost inaudible. In fact, it is one of the quietest I have known."

Dr. Robinson is best known as the founder of "PSYCHIANA," a new school of thought, with its own magazine and brotherhood. He is a pipe organist of wide experience and has installed the instrument for his own pleasure and the pleasure of his family. It has been his life-long dream to have an organ in his home.

"An interesting feature is that the pipe organ has been installed in a modest six-room home," said Mr. Chase. "Dr. Robinson purchased the property after it had been displayed as a model house, having been built and furnished under the direction of the home economics department of the University of Idaho. It won honorable mention in the national better homes contest in 1930."

Six years ago Dr. Robinson was working as a clerk in a drug store in Moscow, Idaho. He decided to put his philosophy of life to the test. He decided to find out whether or not the power of God could bring his heart's desire and visions into being. His teachings went like wildfire and inside of one year he owned the above beautiful home, which cost nearly \$9000 without the pipe organ. In addition to this he owns a beautiful car and owns controlling

interest in an organization which is eminently successful. He carries many thousand dollars worth of life insurance, and if he were to die tomorrow his loved ones would be amply cared for. And less than six years ago he did not have a penny to his name and was thousands of dollars in debt. All of the above have been secured through the application of the Spiritual God-Law this course of instruction teaches.
