1. TAKEN from tender of LOCOMOTIVE "9" as CHARLES BRONSON, "DEAKIN" - fought with Archie Moore "Carlos" atop "snow covered" box car (also equipped with emergency hand rails along either side of top of car) as train was moving very carefully about 10-12 MPH on descending grade between Summit + Headquarters, Idaho. "Carlos" lost the fight being thrown over side of car while passing over Bridge 36.

(A4) 2. TAKEN AT Arrow Junction on "Maiden trip" east from Lewiston to Orifino Idaho. At this point Diesel unit and road caboose were detached and run ahead of "Breakheart Pass" train so that helicopter shots could be made of steam locomotive pulling vintage cars along Clearwater river. Although tender is stacked with cord wood, steam was made by hand firing locomotive with coal.

(F2) 3. Preparing for "Indian attacks" on train at Craig Junction prior to dynamiting of car carrying illegal rifles and ammunition in pine coffins. This car is immediately behind locomotive.

4. Black powder smoke bombs resulting from dynamite being thrown into supply car as Indians ransacked car to secure rifles + ammunition. "Dynamite" was thrown by DEAKIN (Charles Bronson) riding by on horseback (Rider in picture is not Bronson)
