We reached Cakley on the 7th and We're staying in an old country school house with Only four rooms. It was disappointing to have to live for 3 wher in an old place still incomplete of plambing and other necessities, but within The 3 days we're been here, things have improved quete a bit, Our girls room is still crowded, but I suppose that just can't be helped. Just yesterday, I started doing farm work for The first time is my lips and I can assure you, it's nothing easy. We had to pick spude all day, and by the time I got through I was so dirty and tired, that I couldn't do ampthing, there is no shower in this school either, so we've just got to get along without any. My partner and I actually picked 180 half sacks of potatoes! We consider that as pretty good for the first day. my partner's picked before, but This was my first time. This morning, I could Kardly move around eause my bones were crocking all over. I'm hoping that I'll get used to I haven't written to you for so long that In wondering is to what you are doing, are you is good health, Oje San? I heard that some men might come up into Idaho to do Some sort of work, but you are you by any chence coming? It would be so nice if you could come. I wonder how everyone is at home ? I haven't written to them yet, so I don't know

What's going on in Hunt. Oh yes, I haven't thanked you for the nice package you sent to us quite a long time ago. Those slippers were so the cleverly made, did you made it? and those cheese - tid bits, I like them so much. We don't have augthing like that at Hunt. Thank youvery much, though. . Oje-san, has anything happened about your rehearing ? Well, I think I'll lave to close This letter now, fut I'll be writing again soon. In the meantime Oll te waiting for any news from you.
