Here's the ewe/lamb study proposal for the NRA grant. The first step will be to consolidate it into one original. Holly & I will have individual information for the biographical segments - III, IV, V. We have penciled in our individual info. on these parts. Since segments VI, VII, VIII apply to the study in general they need only appear once, on the original application.

The "body of the study outline" is an MS. word (micro soft 3.1) under the filename NRA prop. Hopefully, you and/or Ed can go over this to do some final editing.
