GD-Y077 (income account) has a balance of \$880.00. I have allocated that to cover Reed Lewis' per diem expenses through the remainder of his employment as winter caretaker (May 1). Those expenses will require the entire \$880.00.

GD -X100 (operating account) has a balance of \$3,300. I have encumbered some monies to cover the regular expenses incurred through Arnold Aviation for monthly radio, propane, freight, etc (approx. \$1,500). The remainder will cover Reed's salary (\$250.00/pay period for 6 pay periods = \$1,500) through May 1. There'll be travel costs to bring the -Lewis's out and take me in this spring. Obviously, we'll be lucky to squeak by for the remainder of the fiscal year.

My understanding is that the Bleak Endowment will cover expenses for ges two wilderness interns this summer. That's \$5,700 (\$5,000 for both salaries and the remainder to cover air charter both ways).

An approximate operating budget for June - December 1996 follows. The proposed budget would leave about \$5,200 for the remaining six months of the fiscal year (Total fiscal year budget = \$14,600).
