I thought you might want this statement from Real Woods. The new charge controller is installed and works nicely. It came with instructions for testing the controller using resistance between pairs of the 4 wires, the old controller failed.

Ray A. was going to try to pick up the necessary parts for mounting the 12 propane lights in Boise this week. We'll know today if he got them.

We have built the new "quick-take-down" fence at the head of the airstrip and it seems to work well. We've also started putting together the historical display.

The two C.O.'s from the fish and game caught 11 steelhead, but only landed 4, in the hole at Rush Creek. They theorize there are ~50 steelhead in the hole waiting for proper conditions before moving up Rush Creek to spawn. The C.O.'s fished their way up to Cabin Creek and we've not heard of their success. The 4 landed fish were all A-run, bright colored, and not yet ripe for spawning.
