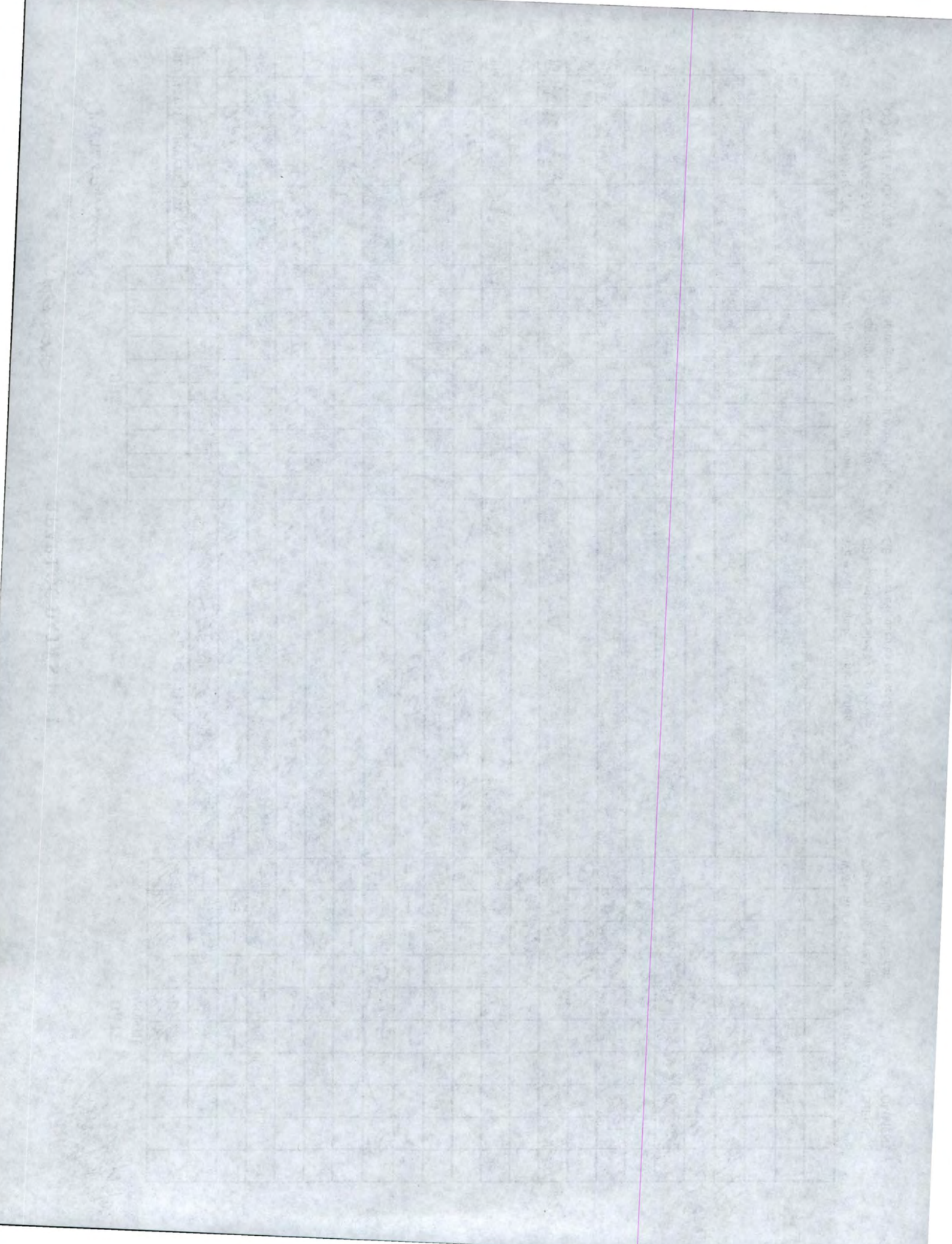

Trap Type and Description of Foot/Leg Injuries (indicate which foot was caught).

Front left foot - 2 toes only - caught in McBride #4 Rubber Jawed Trap. Wolf was fighting trap when approached, but was likely not in trap long (trap transmitter not active at 11pm, but was active 6:30 am w/ wolves howl distant @ 7am). No swelling on toes, no broken skin, toe flexibility similar on both feet, but wolf responded to movement of those toes early in anaesthesia. No extra heat in those toes/foot. Minor scrapes on back legs & poss. broken premolar tooth from fighting trap in brush.

Other Comments

This wolf was small sized & thin - ribs easy to feel. Hair coat over hips was matted. A one-year old or two year old. We were concerned about high body temperature, so decided not to booster drug dose to allow extra time to draw blood.

Suspected / known origins, pack information, other, etc.: Probably Golden Pack, as this area is within Golden Pack H.R. and a radio collared Golden Wolf had been utilizing this mule carcass along with 3+ other wolves ^{intermittantly} for 12 days. No radio collared wolf around for last 3 days, altho non instrumented wolves were around.

Trap Type and Description of Foot/Leg Injuries (indicate which foot was caught).

Rubber jawed foothold on left front foot. Trap hit just above main pad. Foot was swollen with indentation from trap. Some superficial abrasions. Wolf was in trap >7 hours and <15hrs based on trap transmitters and misinterpretation of signals in AM. Trap hung up 80M from capture site. Wolf had fought trap and had fresh blood in mouth (no specific injury site found) and tendons on all 3 non trap legs were heavily abraded and bruised; no punctures. Administered nitrofurazone to all legs.

Other Comments

This wolf was thin/bony like B229. Empty stomach. Hair coat looked fine.

I sent 1 purple top to DVM Keith Ruble. Other purple tops to Arnold Aviation, plus will send ear tissue sample & frozen serum to AA for NPT.

Isaac said they usually send all purple tops to Ashland - refrig for up to 7 days or freeze if need to.
