Please make it no longer than 14 minutes to allow one minute for introduction and five minutes for discussion. Moderators will be strictly enforcing the 20-minute total time limit for each presentation. If for some reason, the session falls behind, it will be necessary to shorten presentations to 15 minutes. Please bring approximately 100 copies of your presentation for distribution to the press and symposium participants at the beginning of the symposium. This week you should have received a registration booklet. Be sure to register directly with the congress. It would be useful to us if you would let us know the times you will be at the congress and where you will be staying.
