Dear Jim:

We still plan to meet with you on the 5th of March and will return to Taylor Ranch on the 7th. I am enclosing a travel request form for your signature.

We received the meteorological station computer program from Ed Krumpe. Thanks. We will bring the computer, storage module, program, manual, etc out when we go to Moscow, so we can get some help downloading data from the storage module to the computer. There should be some money in the air quality budget for getting the computer program running properly. Can Ed line someone up to look at the problem?

Jim sent reimbursement receipts to Lynne Kittner (about \$250) - mostly propane gas line parts. Jim has redone all the connections from gas tanks into cabins with rubber hose, hand tighteners, and new regulators where necessary, for improved safety and efficiency.

We are expecting 4 Fish and Game people in next week to help us with bighorn sheep capture. The Forest Service was planning to stay at Taylor Ranch several days for a wolf survey, but decided to stay at Cabin Creek, closer to the survey area. The Nampa High School Science Club is making a backpack trip from Cabin Cr. to the Flying B over spring break. We invited them to spend a night at Taylor Ranch and will give them several talks on the history, natural history and research of the area.

We watched a mountain lion on an elk it killed in the pasture. That was exciting!
