EMPLOYMENT CONDITIONS

- 1) Extended Education faculty appointments are contingent on the needs of the program as determined by student enrollment.
- 2) Resident faculty are given first consideration for appointment, though Extended Education teaching assignments are neither required of nor guaranteed to resident faculty.
- 3) Tenure, rank and seniority are not determining factors in employing Extended Education faculty.
- 4) An Extended Education faculty appointment is a temporary appointment for a specific period of time.
- 5) Salaries are determined according to the Schedule for Special Sessions as adopted by the Board of Trustees of the California State University. Resident faculty are appointed at the rank equivalent to their appointment for the preceding academic semester.
- 6) According to the provisions of the Salary Schedule, faculty salaries may be reduced for low enrollment as an alternative to cancellation. The determination that a reduced salary is necessary is the responsibility of the Extended Education. Faculty members are not compensated for under-enrolled courses which must be cancelled.
- 7) Faculty members who agree to teach Extended Education courses are obligated to meet their classes for the first meeting, regardless of enrollment. Decisions regarding class cancellation are made prior to the second class meeting.
- 8) Enrollment limits for Extended Education courses parallel limits established by the University. Faculty members who agree to teach Extended Education courses are obligated to teach the courses with enrollments up to the approved limits.
- 9) Faculty members teaching Extended Education courses undergo evaluations by students. The evaluations are used by Extended Education for evaluation of teaching effectiveness only, and do not become part of the permanent record of regularly employed University faculty members. Evaluation procedures are detailed in the Faculty Information Statement included in this appointment packet.

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
