SUBJECT: Tentative itinerary for our work in Taylor Ranch

I would like to spend about three days every other month starting July in the Ranch monitoring the three study plots on the benches. Probably the last week of each month, so if we show up to monitor the long-term plots around July 4th, then let's plan on late Sep, late Nov, late Jan, late Mar, late May, as the approximation. Tentative schedule
