The Forest Supervisors of the Beaverhead, Bitterroot and Deerlodge National Forests have announced their intent to prepare a coordinated plan of management for the 159,085 acre Anaconda-Pintlar Wilderness located in Southwestern Montana.

The plan will be compiled this year and is scheduled to be implemented by July 1, 1976. It will coordinate public use within the constraints of the Wilderness Act, and will establish management direction for each ranger district to follow in administration of the Wilderness.
