SUBJECT: Taylor Ranch Environmental Monitoring: Weather records

This semester I encouraged a senior working on a paper for Technical Writing to look into different equipment available for recording weather data. Both plant and animal ecology studies at the Wilderness Field Station could make use of a system capable of collecting weather information which is similar to the types of data collected by the new system installed at Taylor Ranch.

I am forwarding Jerry Deal's report so you can keep it on file. If the college receives money for capital outlay the report may be useful in choosing equipment to aid in future research.

Finally, I would appreciate being informed of progress toward moving the weather station from it's current - poor location to a site where reliable data can be gathered.
