Weather

Weather can be variable: from 32 degrees and snowing to 100+ degrees. Temperatures near Taylor Ranch are conducive to short sleeves, while long sleeves and a jacket are best for the high country temperatures and mosquitoes.

Additional Information

Gear should be limited to 35 pounds per person for flying in on the bush plane. If needed, arrangements can be made in advance to rent camping items from the University of Idaho Outdoor Program. Once at Taylor Ranch there is no opportunity to buy anything, so bring any special medications or personal items you will need. There will be two times when mail can be sent or delivered. Facilities include log cabins and sleeping tents with bunks. None of the cabins have electricity; some have running water. A shower facility is available.
