Thank you for sending the letters of invitation to persons invited to serve on the Wilderness Research Center Technical Advisory Committee. You raised the question about representation by the State Fish and Game, the National Government, or a politician. The reason for this apparent omission is the fact that all of these areas of interest were recommended as being represented on the Executive Committee advisory to the Wilderness Research Center. Further, you will recall that one member from the Executive Committee was to be voted by that committee to serve on the Technical Advisory Committee and visa versa. This does not mean to imply that I would object to representatives of either or all of these groups serving on the Technical Advisory Committee. However, in view of the committees large size already you may wish to reconsider the addition of these areas of influence.

As regards an affiliate appointment for Dr. Hendee, I believe that it will be necessary to gain the concurrence of both the College of Forestry and the Graduate School to implement an appointment. I will discuss this matter with Dean Ehrenreich at the first opportunity.

I note at the bottom of your memorandum that you have made a note that Regent's action will be required for implemental of the Advisory Committee. If this is the case, I wonder if it wouldn't be well to consider the Executive Committee at the time. This committee, as you will recall, was to be appointed by the President. It would seem that if Regent's approval is required on these committees that confusion would be avoided if the committees were proposed to the Regents at the same time.
