As we discussed in our meeting January 14, my wife, Jette, should receive some salary during the summer for her efforts at Taylor Ranch Field Station. Each summer Jette assists me in operation of the field station. She is instrumental in getting cabins ready for visitors, she hosts visitors while I'm away from the field station for research and teaching, she covers the backcountry radio, records daily weather readings, cares for field station horses, assists with irrigation and other field station chores, etc. Essentially, Jette is the additional layer of glue that keeps the day-to-day functioning of the field station together. Currently, caretakers are paid \$500.00 per pay period (2 weeks). I believe that Jette's efforts over the 2.5 months that she is at the field station probably work out to at least two week's effort on her part. Therefore, I propose that she be paid \$500.00 each summer for her help at Taylor Ranch. These monies would come from Budget #686-X100 allocated to irregular help.
