The aims of this national theater education program are to identify and promote quality in college-level theater production. To this end, each production entered is eligible for a response by a regional KCACTF representative, and students compete to participate in KCACTF programs involving awards, scholarships and special grants for actors, playwrights, designers and critics at the regional and national levels.

Productions entered in the Participating level are eligible for inclusion at the KCACTF regional festival and may also be considered for invitation to the national festival at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington D.C. in the spring of 2003. Last year, more than 1,100 productions and 20,000 students participated in the ACTF nationwide. By entering this production, our department is sharing in the KCACTF goals to help college theater grow, and to focus attention on the exemplary work produced in college and university theaters across the nation.

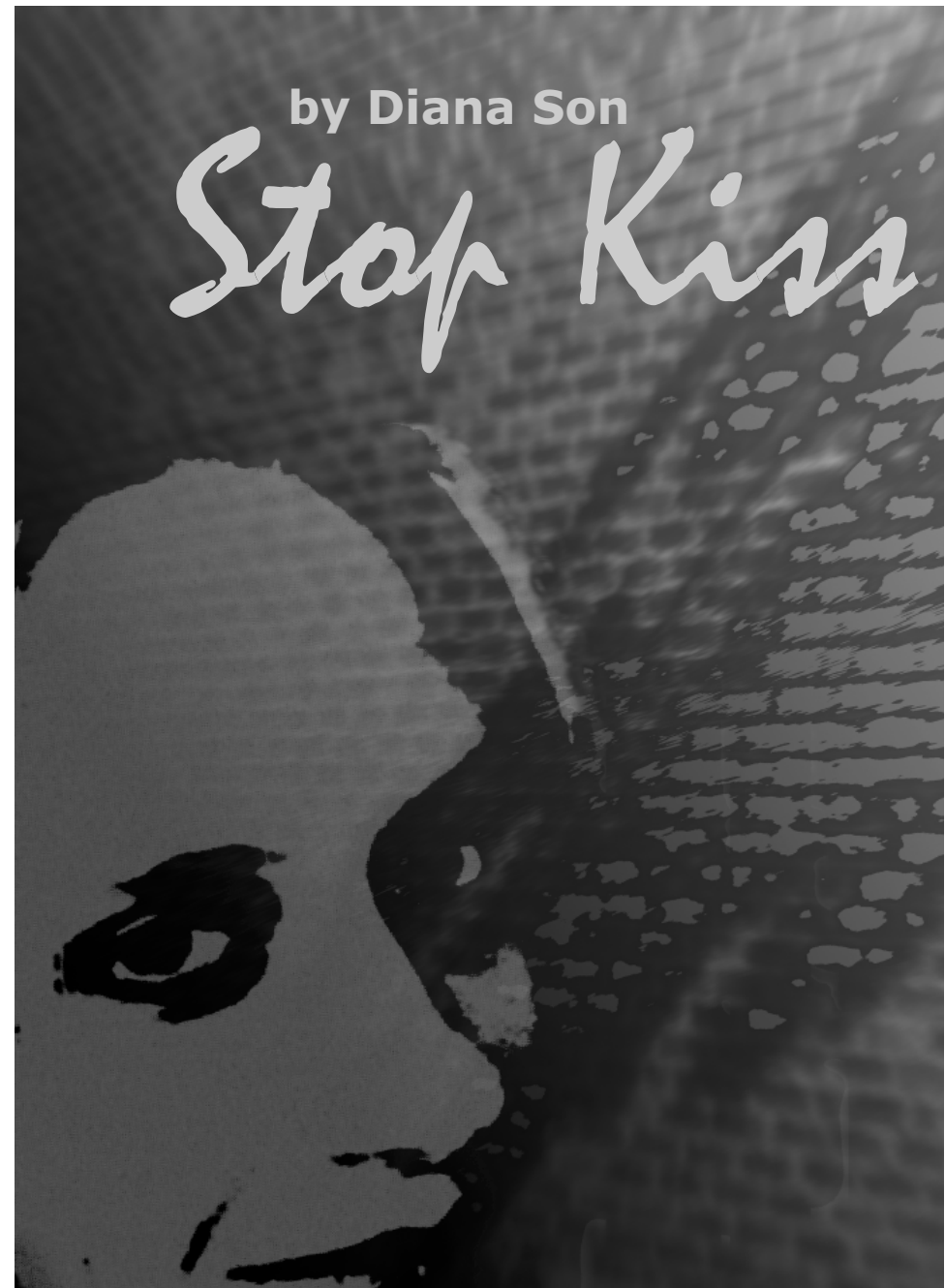
