293 Mouth of Cave Creek
297 Bellingham Ranch
298 Acorn Butte Lookout. Vinegar Hill behind ridge
Elev.20-Azimuth 120 other side of ridge is the Middle Fork
180-240 Temporary camp for Eagan Point L.O.
300 Dave Lewis-Taylor Ranch
300-324 Cliff Creek drainage
310 Horse Mountain Lookout
315 Near creek below is an old much used Indian camp
340 Directly below here about 1/2 mile Soldier Bar LF
343 Black Butte former abandon lookout
345 Mouth of Goat Creek and the creek. Big Hill trail
358 Papoose peak
27 Big Hill Lookout (Temporary)
40-50-60 Across the Middle Fork The mountains in the back show part of the Big Horn Crags
During the Sheepeater Indian war the army chased some indians from 316 up to Soldier Bar past Eagan Point then straight East to the Middle Fork River Below, and lost them
